

Guidelines for Camp Cornish

Trash and Food

Everything that is brought to the camp must be taken home with you. This includes but not limited to all food, trash and craft items.

Clean-up

Grounds –

- Pick up anything that does not belong in nature and put it in your trash bag.
- Clean tools and replace into basement
- Clean latrine if used.

Lodge –

- Clean bathrooms and kitchen appliances.
- Mop all floors: Mop bucket, rag mop, water and small amount of dish soap.
- Scour and clean sink.
- Leave dishtowels spread out to dry.
- Clean tables of spills, crumbs and art debris.
- Winter: Turn thermostat down to 60*
Summer: Turn A/C off
- Put new trash bags in containers upon exit.
- Leave furniture in place as you found it.
- Lock windows and doors.
- Place key into lockbox.

Fire Rings/ Fireplace

- Fires must be attended at all times.
- Let ashes cool before removing. Warm ashes could cause a woods fire.
- Once ashes are cool to the touch, scatter **far** into the woods.
- **Holes dug for fire pits and fire rings must be filled in and sod replaced before leaving camp.**

Wildlife

- Please leave wild animals alone. This camp is their home.

Creek

- Play in the creek at your own risk.

Storms

- In case of emergency, lodge basement should be used as storm shelter.

Rules

SET IN PLACE FOR SAFETY OF YOU AND THE CAMP

- No concealed carry
- No use of alcohol or illegal drugs
- No pets. Service animals are permitted but must be in work attire during the day. Clean up after is expected.
- No on-the-ground use of tobacco products
- No fireworks

Any violations of these rules mean immediate dismissal from the property.

Items to bring to Camp-

- Paper towels
- Hand Soap
- Dish soap (no dishwasher)
- Trash bags
- Scouring pads to clean pots
- Cleaners for bathrooms and kitchen

Violation of Camp Cornish Rules entails a \$50.00 clean up fee
